

About the Teacher

Steve Kotansky is a world-renown teacher and choreographer of dances from Central and Southeastern Europe, including Hungary, Romania, Greece, Albania and the countries of the former Yugoslavia. His exciting teaching and energy, along with his wide knowledge of dance styles, have made him one of the most popular instructors on the international folkdance scene today.

Raised in the San Francisco area, Steve moved to Los Angeles where he danced with the Aman Folk Ensemble and taught at folk dance cafes in the area. In 1972, he received a scholarship from the Rubi Vucheta Memorial Fund to study in the former Yugoslavia. He then lived in Munich for 7 years, where he continued his teaching and research into Balkan dance, both at ethnic communities in Munich and the surrounding countries.

Since moving back to the United States in 1979, Steve has taught at most of the major folk dance camps and festivals in North America and choreographed for several folk dance companies, particularly on Hungarian and Transylvanian dance. He continues to visit Europe to research and teach dances.
